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## **Dolores-1 Progress Report - West Black Lake Gas Project**

Since our last report, clean-up flow operations through a separator have continued. Most frac fluids have been recovered but gas flow rates continued to decline to approximately 0.6 million cubic feet of gas per day ("MMCFD"). At present, testing has been halted to enable a work-over rig to clean 39 feet of fill out of the well and to reset production tubing about 200 feet deeper in to the reservoir. Flow testing is expected to resume in a few days.

With the very preliminary data available at this time, it appears that the frac has not been effective. That is, the frac did not increase gas flow by as much as is normally anticipated in this type of reservoir. A further period of several days of flow, followed by a pressure build up test, will enable the effectiveness of the frac to be properly evaluated. Further action will be considered when the data has been analysed.
